





Meet Antonio (Tony) Puorto. Tony was born on June 7, 1953 in the small town of Ruviano in the province of Caserta to Giovanni and Angelina Puorto. The family also included his brother Alfonso. Unfortunately when Tony was only eight years of age his father died in a scooter accident. Tony was placed in a seminary school for two years in the city of Alife and then spent another two years in school in the city of Aversa. He finally returned home to Ruviano at the age of fourteen for his final year of schooling where he completed seconda media.

After Tony completed his schooling the family received some good news. The documents for immigration to America were ready. The family left for Naples to meet with the Italian Consulate, to get the necessary shots and to pass the required physical exam. The family left Italy on June 14, 1968 and arrived in America after spending seven days on the ship Michelangelo. It was early in the morning of June 21st when the family was awaken to see the Statue of Liberty as they were passing by. It was an unforgettable moment with everyone cheering and rejoicing because they had finally arrived in America. Tony and the family were met by relatives and driven to Schenectady.

The family stayed at Tony's aunt's house for a brief period until they could get enough money together to rent a house on Hattie Street. Tony's aunt had been born in Waterbury, Conn. and because she was an American citizen the family was able to come to America. Tony was 15 years of age and knew no English. Nevertheless he went to Avon Market and got a job working after school. During the day he went to Oneida Jr. High School and then on to Linton High School where he graduated in 1972. Following school he worked at a number of jobs including working in the kitchen at Ellis Hospital, as a mason's helper, as a painter with his cousin Romeo, back to Ellis as a maintenance worker and then GE for 6 years before getting laid off. Tony then enrolled in the Europa School of Cosmetology where he graduated got a diploma and license and has worked as a cosmetologist ever since.

In 1984 the good news continued, Tony married Kim Darpino! Together to their great joy they raised three children Gabriella, Giovanna and Gianluca and have been blessed with two grandchildren Lucy and Massimiliano.

There were difficult days in the past but now there are good days.
