
THE AMERICAN ITALIAN HERITAGE MUSEUM

Its mission is to preserve our Italian heritage for present and future generations. The museum contains 10 exhibit rooms, a library with approximately 2000 books on Italian American and Italian topics and conducts a variety of events, classes and programs keeping alive our rich Italian culture. In addition to the variety of exhibits the walls are filled with information regarding the immigration of Italians and the hardships endured by them. The museum is well worth a visit; it is the center of Italian information in the Capital District and a number of college students have used the museum for research purposes. The museum also offers a number of opportunities for those interested in volunteering and learning more.


VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH



Meet Sal Cannistraci. Salvatore Cannistraci was born September 26, 1947 in Torre Forte, Funari, Messina, Sicily. He is one of six children of Carmela Isgro and Santo Cannistraci. When he was 11, he went to Vigliatore - 15 minutes from home - to learn auto mechanics. The following year, he went to Barcelona to continue his auto mechanic apprenticeship.
