



The fee for new members will be \$80 which will include dues for the first year of membership. The move to increase dues was not taken lightly. Costs to maintain the Lodge have increased and while in the past the Lodge has been able to absorb increases, it can no longer do so and still remain financially viable. 


VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH
